Effective, 6/2007 strictly enforced:

Boys—Swim suits must be at or above waistline, not showing any underwear, boxers, etc. Girls—Swim suits must be 1-piece can be worn without a shirt. 2-piece swim suits are allowed if a t-shirt is worn over them. Tankinis are allowed. Shorts and shirts must be worn at all meals, group gatherings, and rides to and from camp or any other function, unless otherwise stated. If at anytime a leader, counselor, or camp director deems a swim suit to be inappropriate, regardless of the above rules, student will be asked to either change or put a t-shirt over the swimsuit.

Things you might need for a week away from mommy and daddy:

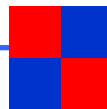
Sleeping bag and pillow, towels, sunscreen bathroom utensils especially deodorant swimsuit (see policy on other page)

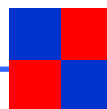
